P/Lazy E Ranch – Michael and Kendra Anderson, 46043 Co Rd Y, Akron CO 880720

From Brush & points West –

From I-76 use Exit 92, Turn right for about a mile, and then left on Hwy 34, after proceeding East past the Pinneo Feedlot go 15 or so more miles on Hwy 34, look for an old feedlot on the North side of the road. Turn North on Road Y, it is about 4.5 miles to the P slash Lazy E Ranch. Turn West into the ranch.

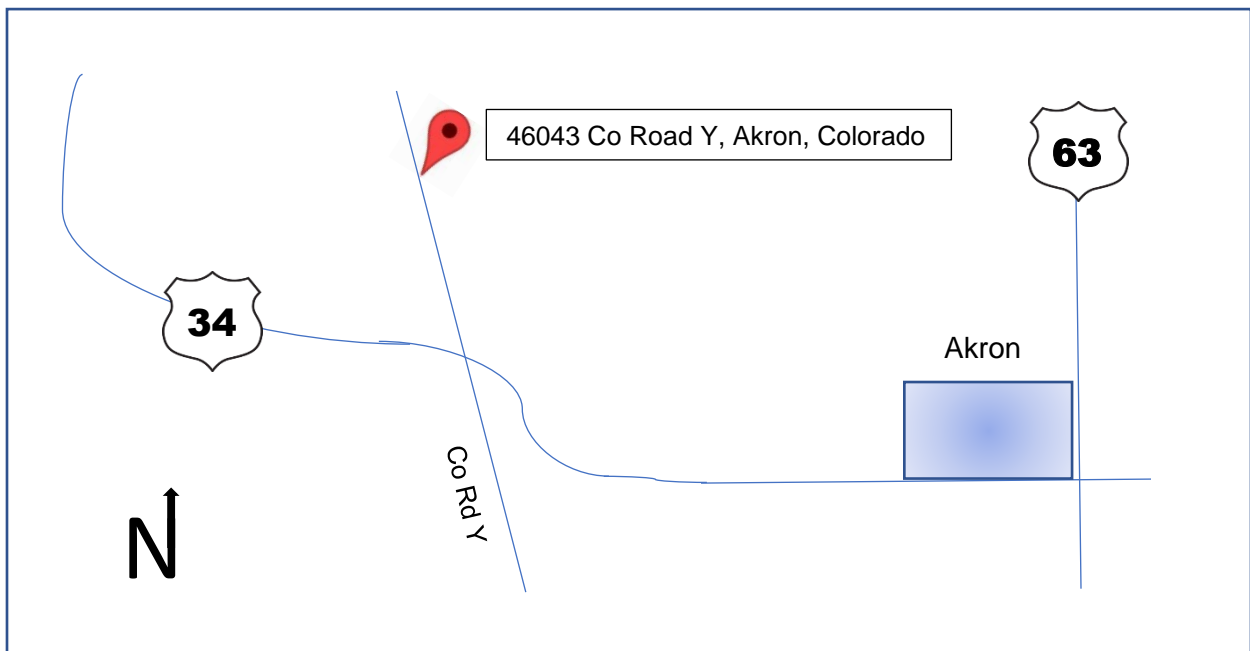
From Akron & points East –

Proceed West on Hwy 34 four miles to the feedlot, turn North on Road Y then 4.5 miles to the Ranch.

From Sterling & points North –

Take the Atwood exit off I-76 and proceed South on Hwy 63 for 15 miles or so, turn West on Road 50. It's about 4 miles to Road Y, then proceed South about 4 more miles to the Ranch.
